## How can Training help?

The OFSCI brought this incident forward due to the sudden and extreme change in fire behavior that necessitated that a firefighter perform a low profile emergency window bailout. Although this firefighter was injured, firefighter survival training and appropriate use of PPE prevented a more serious outcome.

Based on the information available to the committee, the OFSCI is recommending the Ontario Fire Service review the following information:

- Review Guidance Notes and corresponding department SOPs:
  - o <u>GN 4-1: Firefighter Protective Equipment</u>
  - <u>GN 6-6: Rapid Fire Progression</u>
  - o <u>GN 7-4: Firefighter Survival and Self-Rescue Training</u>

- Practice the following skills according to department training programs:
  - Low profile maneuvers
  - Emergency window egress
